What is a Housekeeping Zoning By-law?

- An amendment to the current zoning by-law to correct minor anomalies, clerical inconsistencies, inadvertent omissions and to clarify minor matters.
- A housekeeping amendment is not a tool to make sweeping changes it is administrative in nature.
- The current by-law came into force in 2004 and municipal staff have been tracking minor changes through their experience implementing the by-law – those needed changes are included in this amendment.



Key Changes in this Housekeeping ZBA

- Updating the zone names of CH (Commercial Highway) and CG (Commercial General) to HC and GC so that the read Highway Commercial and General Commercial
- Typographical error corrections like adding the words "a" or "an" where appropriate.
- Issues of clarity like removing the word "uses" from a title.
- Correcting terms such as "frontage" to read "front yard" to be consistent with definitions.
- Correcting numbering of sections.



Key Changes in this Housekeeping ZBA

- Correcting the legal descriptions of a few by-law amendments to be accurate.
- Replacing the word "principle" with "principal" in several sections.
- Adding accessible parking provisions to the parking space requirement table.
- A definition for Public Use was added.
